The camp is set in beautiful bushland adjacent to state forest and bound by the Loddon River. It received a million dollar overhaul in 2007 and has everything to make a summer holiday one to remember for all children.

## Facilities

- accommodation building includes bedrooms and bathrooms; 2 bunks per room;
- mattresses and pillows are provided;
- large outdoor covered BBQ area and picnic area;
- children's playground, trampoline and ropes course;
- concert Stage; Home theatre;
- large gymnasium, recreation room and dining room.

**Campers will need to bring their own sleeping bags, pillow case and towels.**

## Activities include

- bike riding, volleyball and team sports;
- pool and table tennis;
- excursions to local pool and other favourites such as Sovereign Hill;
- every child receives a souvenir T-shirt;
- team events, games, karaoke.
